### Introducing Forest School to York Road

Laura and Sally two of our LSAs have been on a 'Forest School' course. They have come back with lots of amazing ideas for outdoor play. We plan to have a forest school type day regularly every other Friday starting soon. We will be outside all day in all weathers.

Your children will need to bring in some spare clothes, wellies, waterproofs appropriate for the weather.

The children will get messy.

At this age all our children are beginning to become inquisitive about their bodies. At York Road we are teaching them that some areas of their bodies covered by underclothing are private parts and not to be shown to everyone. Appropriate behavior of this nature is tricky to get across to such small children and we would appreciate your help to reinforce our message.
