This year we are having baby ducks. The eggs will be arriving Tuesday 21st April.



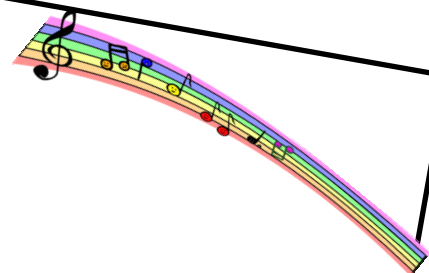
Wood visit
