Bring in a piece of fruit or vegetable to eat at snack time



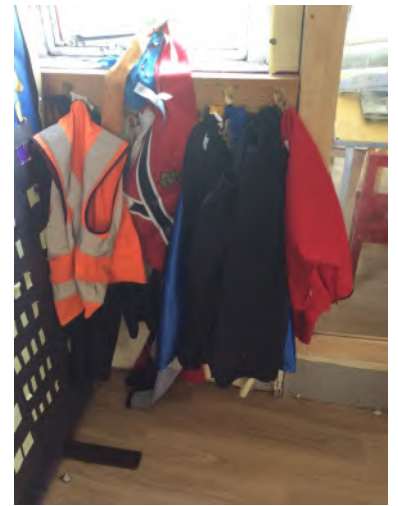
## Creative Area

Role Play - you can dress up, have a tea party, play cafés or be your favourite story character!



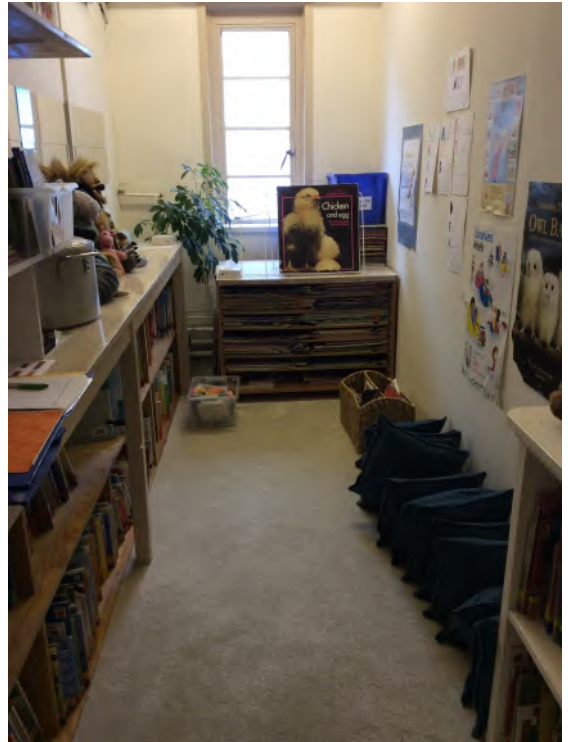
# Floor Toys

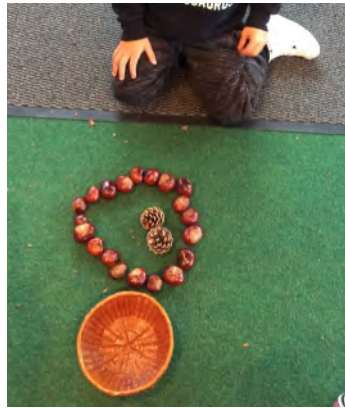

# Loose Parts

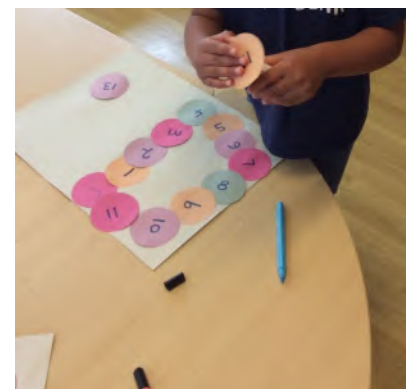
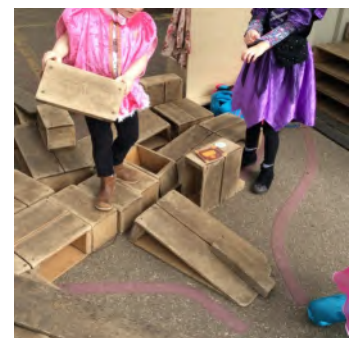


You can make arrangements or patterns with loose parts or have fun sorting them.



# Maths

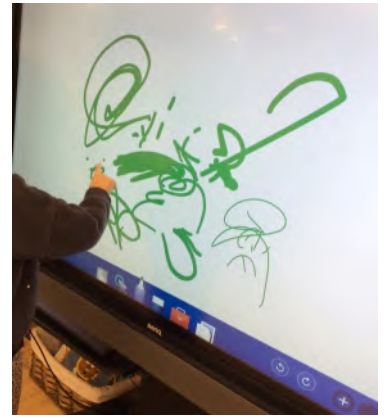
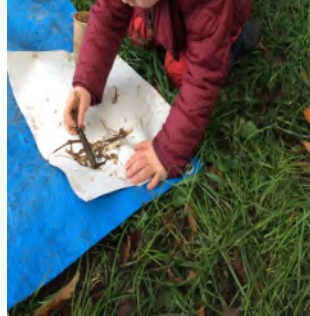
There are lots of things to sort, measure, weigh, build with and count, as well as games to play.



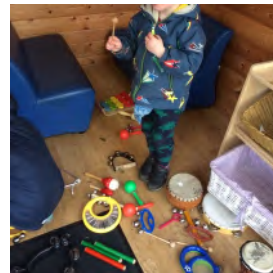


# Mark-Making

Listening walks, rhymes, stories, phonics activities, rhyming, keeping the beat.

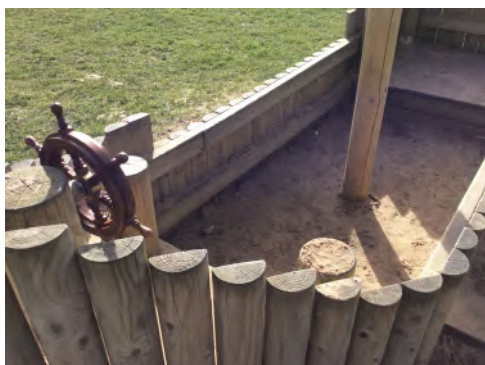
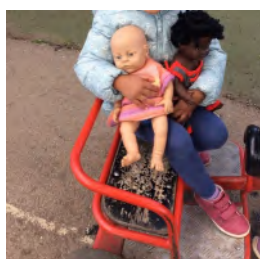
# Communication

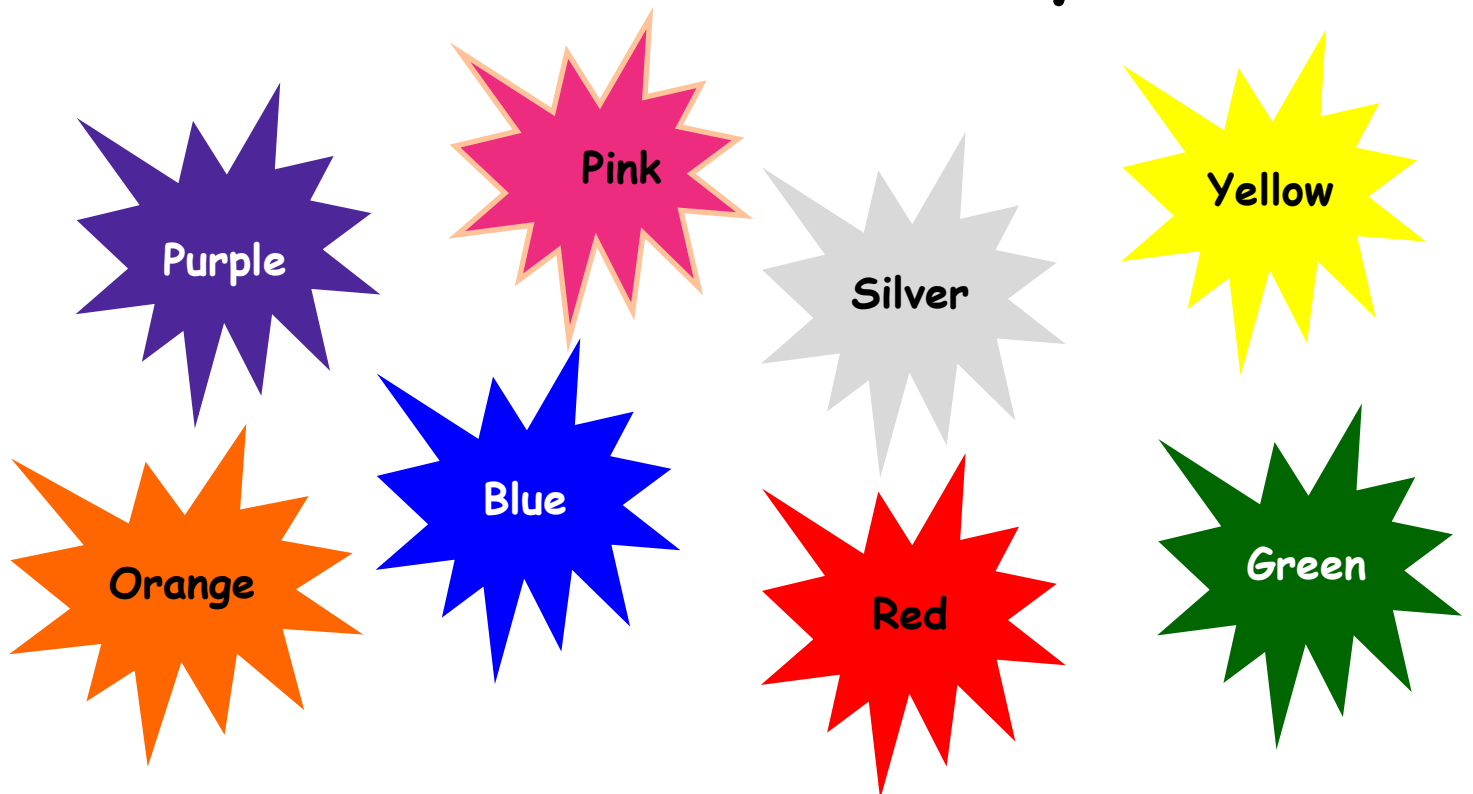
