Bring in a piece of fruit or vegetable to eat at snack time



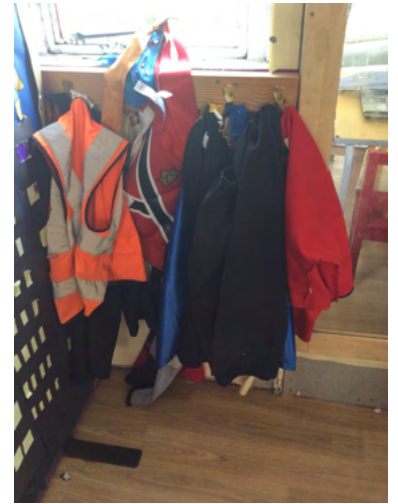
Creative Area

You can make arrangements or patterns with loose parts or have fun sorting them.



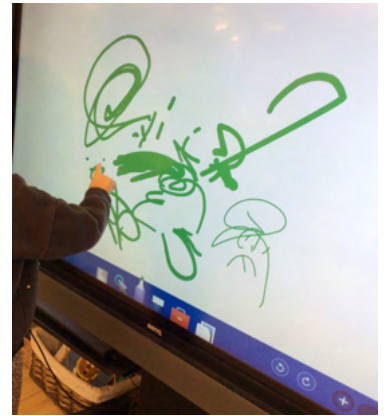
Maths

There are lots of things to sort, measure, weigh, build with and count, as well as games to play.

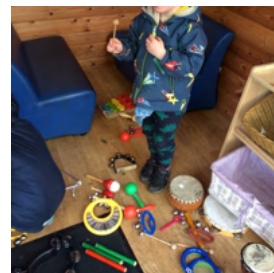


Mark-Making

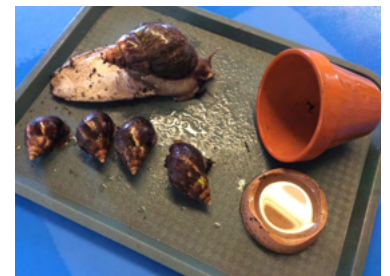


Forest School

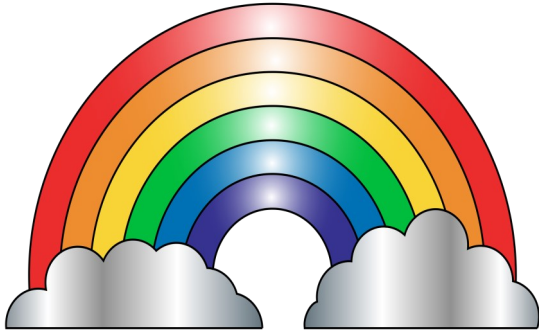
