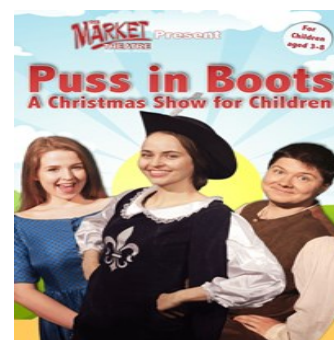
if your child is in pre-school and does not attend on those days, please call the school office to arrange what time to come in for the photo.
