SAFEGUARDING

If your child has a medical appointment in the morning, this includes vaccinations and dental appointments, then they cannot return to Nursery until 12pm, if they are here all day either in Yorkies or Rainbows.

If your child has a medical appointment in the afternoon then they can be picked up at 12pm but they cannot return to school for the remainder of the afternoon.

Children should not be picked up or dropped off half way through a morning or afternoon session. Feel free to inform the school office of a medical appointment and we will mark it in the registers as such.

Please remember that if your child needs Calpol or similar before coming to school then they should not be attending.

If your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea then they must stay off school for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness and/or diarrhoea..



Please could we remind parent's that our drop off times are 9.00am and the side gate will be closed at 9.10am. 12.00pm pick up at the side gate and will be closed at 12.10pm. 3.30pm pick up is at the side gate for 30 hour children. Please could we ask that these times be adhered to. Could we also ask that all parents use the one way system for exiting the Nursery.

We are sure you will agree keeping your children safe is our utmost concern

General Information

Please do not send in any cakes or biscuits in your child's lunch. These will be returned in the lunchbox. We like to encourage healthy eating.

If your child attends Rainbows please send in a separate snack for the afternoon, aswell as their lunch. If your child attends Yorkie's they are provided with a snack.

Please can we respect our neighbours on York Road when parking our vehicles at drop off and pick up. Please avoid parking outside driveways.

Rabbits and Hedgehogs will be visiting the woods for 4 sessions. This will begin next Wednesday 9th March. Please remember to dress your child in appropriate clothing, and wellies, could you bring your child to nursery ready for the woods. Your child does not need to bring in a morning snack as they have a biscuit and hot chocolate at the woods.
