Please remember all absences will be recorded for your child as **UNAUTHORISED** unless your child is unwell, there is a new baby in the family or there has been a bereavement.

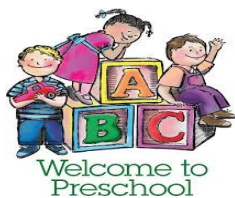
