Information for New Parents

If your child has a medical appointment in the morning, this includes vaccinations and dental appointments, then they cannot return to Nursery until 12.00pm, this is if they attend either Yorkie's or Rainbows.

If your child has a medical appointment in the afternoon you can pick them up at 12.00pm but they cannot return to Nursery for the remainder of the afternoon.

Children should not be picked up or dropped off half way through a morning or afternoon session. Feel free to inform the office of a medical appointment and we will mark it in the registers as such.

Please remember if your child needs Calpol or similar before coming to school then they should not be attending.

If your child has sickness and/or diarrhea then they must stay off school for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness and/or diarrhea.

Contact telephone numbers provided must enable us to contact you at all times whilst your child is in Nursery, if this is a mobile number remember it needs to be turned on!!
