Please download the Arbor app and register your details. The Arbor app is now ready for payments. You will find the 'Voluntary contributions' under 'Club'. You can make a payment in this.

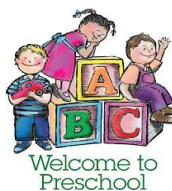

We shall have a Harvest assembly on Friday 14th October. We shall be talking to the children about caring for the community and about the time of the year.



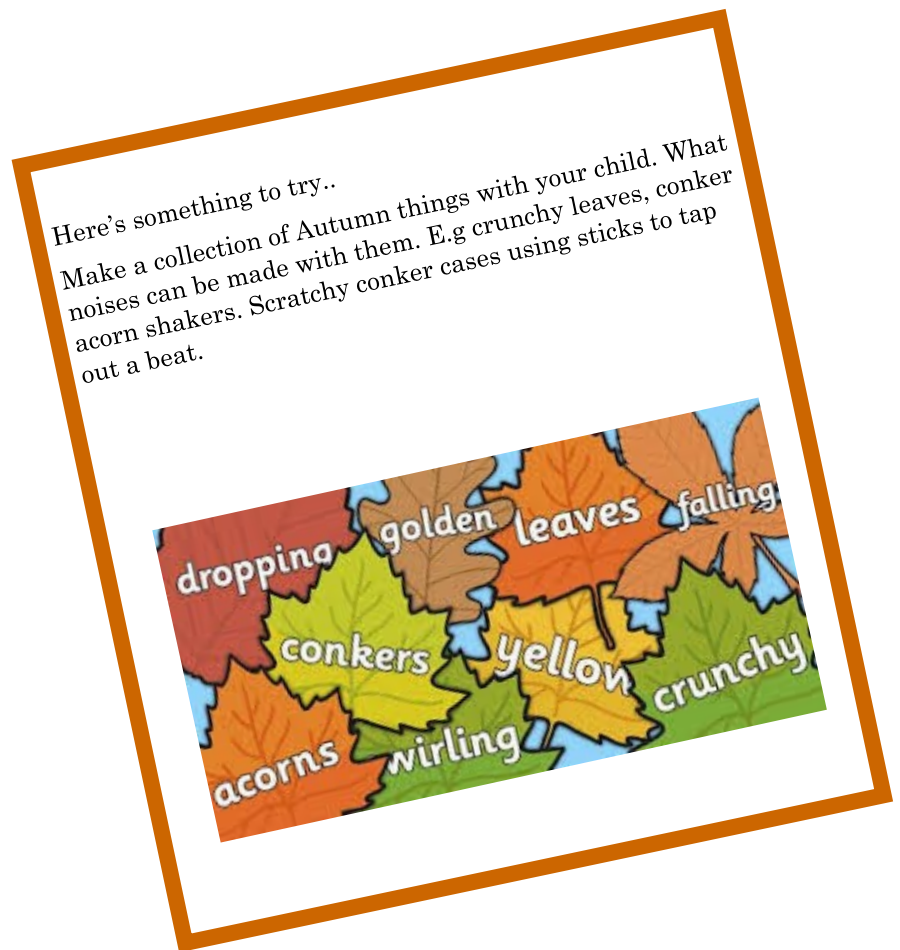
## Cold Weather
