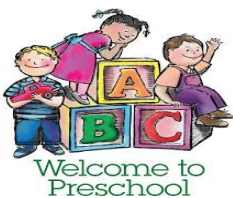

be Foxes and Squirrels.

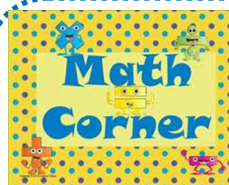


Tapestry!
