Sharing thoughts, ideas, knowledge and understanding. Conveying wants and needs. Listening and being heard.



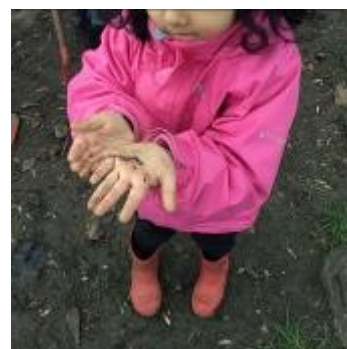
# Outside

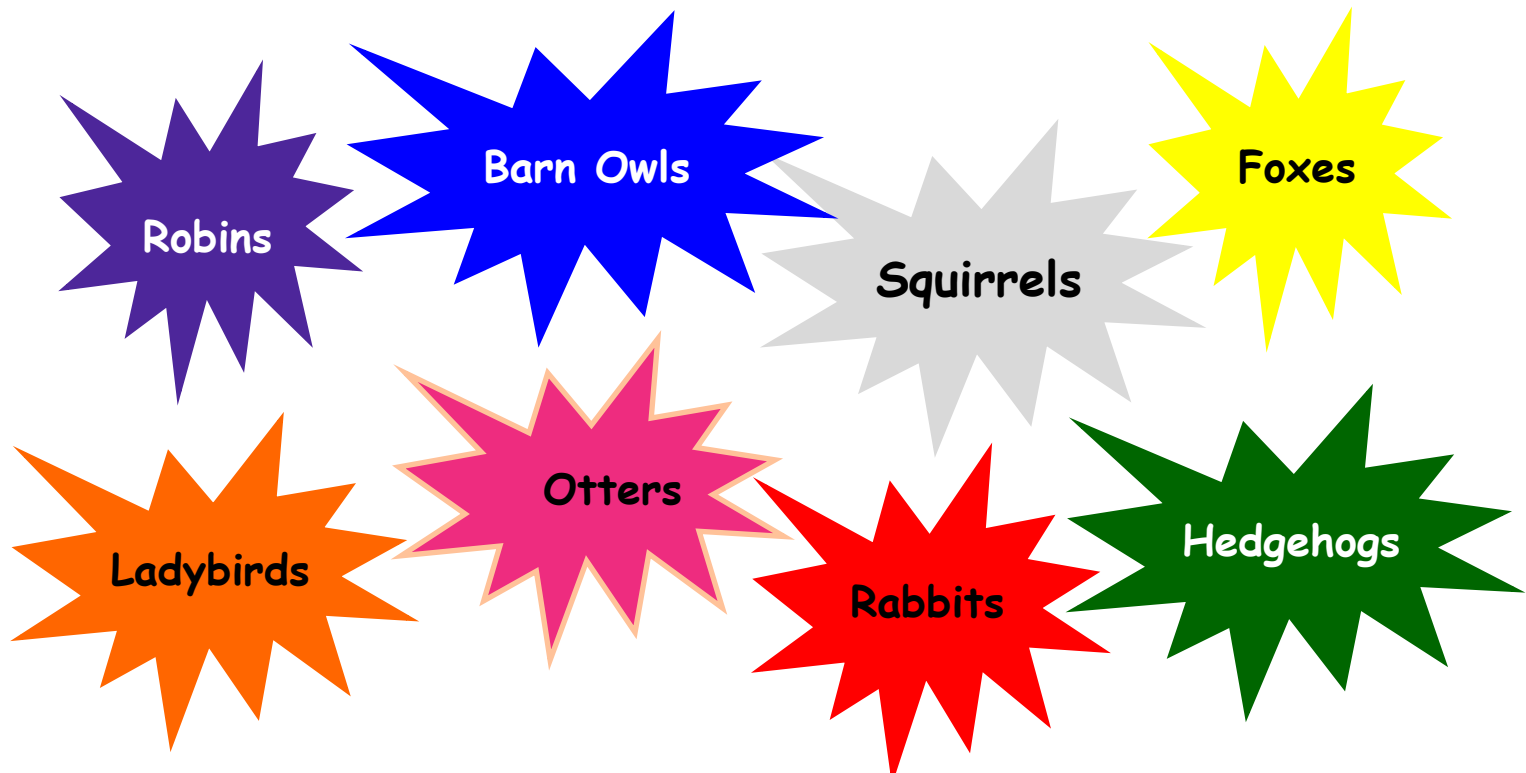
