
The deadline for applying for Primary school places is Monday 15th January.2024. Please apply online at.

Please can you put cutlery in your child's packed lunch. Staff are busy supporting children and not always able to get cutlery also our supply of children's cutlery has dwindled.

PHONIC CORNER

We have been teaching the children to use their 'listening ears', encouraging them to focus on the



sounds around them. If you have time, get your child to sit quietly for 1 minute. Can they tell you the sounds they heard? Can they make a similar sound? Send us a comment on Tapestry.

Pick ups and drop offs

Now we are a few weeks in, please could we remind parents Nursery starts at 9.00am and ends at 12.00pm or 3.30pm if your child does 30 hours. We are finding several children arrive late and this disrupts the rest of the class. Late pick ups also disrupts and upsets children. Although we do understand circumstances can occasionally disrupt your journey. We ask that you leave once you have picked up your child or dropped them off. We are finding if parents are hanging around this can be upsetting for other children and takes away the keyworkers time from the children in the group. Could we ask that parents do not congregate around the exit gate near the wooden shed on the Nursery grounds. This is once again for your children's safety.

Please could you ensure that children do not ride scooters on the Nursery grounds. This is for safety purposes and to avoid accidents.

Please can gates be closed behind you when you enter or leave the premises. We are finding the gates are left wide open many times. This is a hazard for our children, as children sometimes run on ahead.
