Walking to nursery

We have had a few children recently saying that 'boys don't cry' - we are not sure where this has come from - and in light of 40% of children and young people in the UK now having poor mental health - we wouldn't want any child feeling they shouldn't be able to express a feeling. Please come and chat to your child's teacher or key worker if you need to.

Phonics

With your child listening to the sounds around you for one minute talk about what they have heard and try to recreate the sounds with your voices.
