If you would like to have the snails for a weekend please add your name to the sign up sheet. You will find it in the porch area at the main entrance of the nursery.

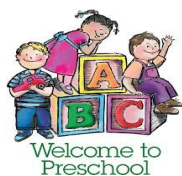
A fact and care sheet will be sent home with the snails - they have been very well behaved so far at nursery.
