To cover costs a voluntary contribution of £5.00 would be much appreciated. Please pay on Arbor and add 'Ark farm' as a reference.

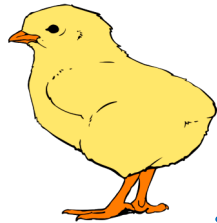
If your child is in receipt of EYPP or you have a two year old at Preschool and you are a supported family you do not need to pay this amount.
