

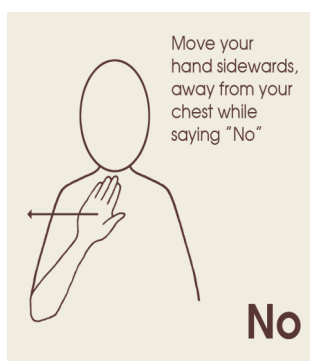

If you would like to dress your child up please do so. We are happy for children to change their clothes after the picture has been taken, however they will have to do that independently.

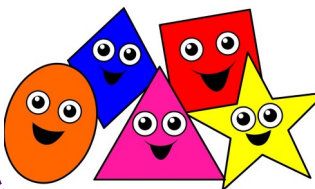
If your child does not attend Preschool on this day, you are welcome to bring them along at 12.30 for a picture to be taken.
