

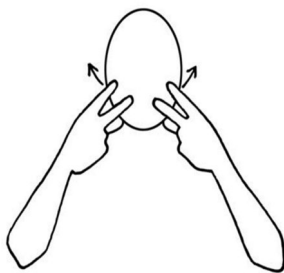

Warmer Weather

As the weather improves, please make sure your child has a hat, water bottle and apply sun cream before they start school. If your child attends Rainbows or Yorkies please could you send your child in with a named sun cream and hand to your child's key teacher so that they can all be kept in a central box, this will then be returned to you at the end of term for the summer holidays. This enables staff to reapply sun cream after lunch as they are going back out to the garden to play.
