We have fish, and giant African land snails too!

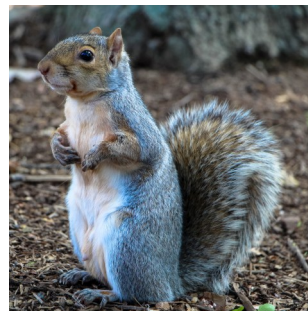


Some children may stay for the afternoon (30 Hours) and other children may go to Yorkies.
